

An Introduction to Braintree Women's Golf Association (BWGA)

The BWGA is a non-profit organization that strives to improve the enjoyment of golf at the Braintree Municipal Golf Course to include sponsoring events and tournaments at the course.

Handicap Services

An initial handicap is assigned after 5 scorecards have been submitted to the Association's Handicap Chairman or through the MGA GHIN Handicap System. Scores can be posted via the Internet, as well as through the golf course computer system, located in the clubhouse.

Tournaments

The BWGA holds tournaments every Tuesday and weekends April through October. To make each one interesting and fun we play a number of different formats (18-hole medal, teams, throw out 3, and more). There are about 80 members and you will have the opportunity to meet and play with a great group of women every week.

Tournament entry fees are \$5 with tournament prizes awarded in the form of chits redeemable for green fees, lessons and merchandise in the Pro Shop.

New in 2017 is the Golf Genius program. You will receive an email inviting you to join a weekly tournament and you can click button for Playing or button for Not Playing. You will receive email from "BWGA Administrator" will tee sheet attached. If you cannot sign up by email, call the Pro Shop.

Meetings

BWGA member meetings are held twice a year. The Spring meeting starts off the season at the clubhouse. The Fall Meeting is held at the end of the season at a restaurant and includes the presentation of awards.
